TICKETS TO GO ON SALE FOR THE 'THINKING GREEN' CONFERENCE

Tickets for the 'Thinking Green' conference being held at the Tercentenary Hall on 21 October will go on sale on Friday of next week, priced at £20, £40, £60 and £80. VIP tickets are available for £300, a price which includes access to the Conference VIP area and the evening's Gala Dinner in St Michael's Cave. The tickets will be available from the Nature Shop in Casemates Square and on-line via Ticketmaster.

The seminar, to be sponsored by the Nature Group and Hassans, will also include a trade fair which now has only limited space available for any firms who still wish to exhibit.

The Conference, which will be addressed by former US Vice President Al Gore, will focus on the concept of a green economy, one which promotes economic, environmental and social well-being. It will highlight the importance of placing environmental considerations at the heart of financial policies and promote a change from the traditional economic model to one which provides equitable improvements in living standards without eroding environmental assets, i.e. sustainable development.
