**CROWN PRINCE OF SAUDI ARABIA VISITS GIBRALTAR**

His Royal Highness Prince Salman Bin Abdul Aziz al-Saud, the Crown Prince of Saudi Arabia, has paid a private visit to Gibraltar on board his superyacht, Tueq, which was moored at 3 East jetty.

Acting Chief Minister, the Hon Gilbert Licudi, and the Hon Neil Costa, Minister for Tourism, Public Transport and the Port were invited on board the Tueq to pay a formal welcome to his Royal Highness and to other members of the Saudi royal family.

Later, the Crown Prince and his party enjoyed a Rock tour and lunch at the Rock Hotel.

The Crown Prince is the next-in-line to 88-year-old King Abdullah's throne. He is also the current Deputy Prime Minister and Defence Minister. He has been governor of the capital Riyadh for many decades.
