Remembrance Sunday

Her Majesty the Queen has approved that Sunday 11th November will be observed as Remembrance Sunday and the usual Gibraltar Ceremony of Remembrance will be held at The British War Memorial, Line Wall Road at noon.

His Excellency the Governor, HM the Queen's representative in Gibraltar, is leading the service and, on his arrival, will read the Bidding. This is followed by the observance of the Two Minutes Silence, the beginning and end of which is signalled by a Saluting Gun. The Last Post will be sounded, after which wreaths are laid, and a non-denominational service follows. The ceremony will conclude with the sounding of Reveille and the Singing of the National Anthem.

Medals and decorations may be worn with civilian dress by all those entitled to do so. Relatives of the dead may also wear them.

Persons/Organisations wishing to lay wreaths are advised that wreaths may be collected from No 6 Convent Place from Monday 5th to Wednesday 7th November inclusive from 10.00 am until noon. On Thursday 8th November wreaths may be collected from No.3 Convent Place. The cost of the wreaths is £25.00 and cheques should be made payable to The Gibraltar Poppy Day Appeal Fund.
