Air Terminal terrace closed to tackle water ingress

The public viewing terrace at the new air terminal building has been closed in order to address a problem of water penetration into the building below. It is estimated that the works will last just under a month.

This is one of a number of reported problems with water ingress at the new air terminal building which are being addressed.

In the last month, apart from water ingress through the public viewing terrace, there has also been the same problem in the staff corridor and central search areas.

It is disappointing that a building which ended up costing about 84 million euros should suffer from water ingress only about twelve months after it was partially opened by the previous administration.
