WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY 2013

The Department of the Environment will once again be taking part in the World Environment Day (WED) celebrations on Wednesday 5th June. WED is the United Nations flagship environmental event, celebrated in more than 100 countries around the world. WED has now become an annual feature in the Department's agenda and this year's theme focuses on trying to minimise food waste.
