The programme includes Mozart - Overture to Le Nozze di Figaro; Mendelssohn - Violin Concerto, Op 64 and Beethoven - Symphony № 4 in B-flat major, Op 60.

I am sure everyone will remember his virtuosity and his great collaboration with the European Symphony Orchestra.
