Survey for Sustainable Transport Plan available online

H.M. Government announced its plans for a Sustainable Traffic, Transport and Parking Plan in April of this year. The aim is to develop a transport system that works for its users, getting them to where they want to go safely and securely, without damaging the environment.

Over the last few months Government officers have been collecting the empirical data that will underpin this plan: conducting surveys on buses, at car parks and roadsides as well as carrying out in-depth household interviews to better understand how and why people move around Gibraltar. Although thousands of people have been interviewed, inevitably not everyone will have had a chance to participate in the surveys to date.

As such, the Government is launching another survey which is available online and will allow anyone interested in making their views known, to do so. The survey can be accessed online from the Government homepage www.gibraltar.gov.gi. The survey is completely anonymous and should take no more than a few minutes to complete.

Having a clear understanding of the problem is the first step towards identifying the solutions. These surveys are your opportunity to become a part of this process; Government would encourage everyone to take part and make their voices heard in order to ensure that the final plan is one that delivers real and effective solutions for all citizens.
