### **Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Bins**

The Department of the Environment is expanding Government's kerbside recycling service to include Waste Electronic and Electrical Equipment (WEEE) bins. These will be placed in six locations next to existing recycling bins, these are the following:

1. Cloister Ramp (next to Central Police Station)
2. Moorish Castle Estate
3. Devils tower road (next to the Laguna Estate)
4. Waterport Road
5. Williams Way Catalan Bay
6. Rosia Road (next to New Mole House Police Station)

The bins will be ready for use and on location on Friday 27th September 2013. The items that members of the public can deposit here are small items of WEEE, such as toasters, kettles, computers, monitors, calculators etc. These bins will be serviced on a regular basis. The items collected from these bins are taken to an authorised recycling centre where certain parts of items are re-used or recycled, reducing waste and Gibraltar's carbon footprint.
