World War Two tunnels transferred to Gibraltar Tourist Board

'Rock and Fortress,' the private concern that has been managing and operating the World War Two Tunnels and O'Hara's Battery attractions has been taken over by HM Government of Gibraltar. The new arrangements will come into place on November 1st.

The existing employees will maintain their jobs and continue to work in the attractions.

Minister for Tourism, Commercial Affairs, Public Transport and the Port Neil Costa MP welcomed the development and thanked Richard Desoiza managing director of 'Let's Go Limited' who was responsible for the management of the sites over these past years.

Mr Costa said: "The Gibraltar Government wishes to place on record its thanks and gratitude to Mr Desoiza for his efficient management of these two important and popular tourist sites which will now be coming under the direct control of the Ministry for Tourism as from November 1st.
