- 2 (a) Location: Gibraltar International Airport

(b) Scope of works: Design and Construction of a new access road linking the City of Gibraltar to the frontier and airport terminal and includes a new dual carriageway with a tunnel under the airport runway linking to the frontier and airport terminal. The total length of the scheme is approximately 1.25km. The scheme is to be designed in accordance with the UK Design Manual for Roads and Bridges as amended by local standards in Gibraltar. The scope of works includes the detailed design of the scheme and construction including but not limited to the main elements: earthworks, retaining structures, tunnel under the airport runway, street lighting works, drainage works, road markings and signage, landscaping and temporary traffic management required to facilitate the works.
