#### TENDER FOR THE DESIGN, MANUFACTURE AND CONSTRUCTION OF A POWER STATION IN GIBRALTAR

- 2 (a) Location: Gibraltar.
- (b) Scope of works: Design, Manufacture and Construction of a new natural gas fired power station of approximate capacity of 80 MW(e) comprising natural gas fired generating units able to deliver a Net Guaranteed heat rate of 42 MW(e) with an output range 7 to 15 MW (e) each. The remaining generating sets are to be dual fired generating units of the same output range should there be a need to operate with an alternative fuel, together with a new Plant Control System for control and monitoring of the electricity generation system and connection to the existing SCADA for the Network system and an electrical distribution centre for the power station. The scheme also includes the provision of the necessary infrastructure for the unloading and transfer of both fuels within the boundary of the new power station.

The scope of works includes the design of the scheme, manufacture, factory testing, supply, delivery, construction, testing, commissioning, handover and maintenance period including but not limited to the following main elements: geotechnical investigations, enabling works, earthworks, foundation, retaining structure, building structures, natural gas and natural gas/diesel generating sets, auxiliary and ancillary equipment, exhaust stacks, power plant electrical distribution centre, electrical equipment and switchgear, fuel unloading, storage and transfer facilities within the site, selective catalytic reduction equipment, electrical switchgear and controls, drainage works, roadworks and signage, temporary works and traffic management required to facilitate the works. In addition, it is expected that the successful tenderer will be required to supplement the work undertaken by the Government in relation to the HAZID, COMAH, EIA and other environmental permitting requirements, including but not limited to dispersion modelling, PPC as well as to undertake an aeronautical assessment for the proposal.
