Government embarks on extensive refurbishment programme for existing playgrounds and establish new ones.

The Government has embarked on its extensive programme to refurbish existing playgrounds and to establish new ones.

All playgrounds are being fitted out to high standards of equipment, including safety and specialist flooring.

The first playground opens to the public for use to-morrow, Friday 4th March at 1pm. This is the playground at the Northern half of the rebuilt Westside Promenade. The play facilities are separated into different sections by age-groups from toddlers up to 14/15 years old. A separate area has also been equipped with a set of outdoor fitness and exercise equipment for adults.

The whole area has been fully landscaped, including trees, and plants, benches and tables.

The facility will be managed by the Gibraltar Sports & Leisure Authority and will be open every day from 8 am to 9 pm. During the summer months these hours will be extended.

Other playgrounds are at Eastern Beach, Rosia Road (La Bateria), Cumberland Road, Lower Witham's Road, Laguna Estate, Line Wall Road (Boulevard Hebreo), Line Wall Road (Sir Herbert Miles Promenade), Europa Point, Catalan Bay and Varyl Begg Estate. All of them are scheduled to be completed by the end of June. Several of them will be available for use sooner than that.
