Footbridge Repairs - Winston Churchill Avenue

As part of essential repair works to the footbridge at Winston Churchill Avenue, a contractor will be undertaking works as from 10:00pm on Monday 24 August 2015 for a period not exceeding 8 hours. Works will involve removal of the main bridge structure with the use of mobile cranes, where it will then be laid down within the car park in front of the Referendum House tower block for the necessary repairs. In order to allow these works to proceed, Winston Churchill Avenue from its junction with the Sundial Roundabout and Glacis Road will be completely closed off to vehicles and pedestrians during this time. Subsequently works to re-assemble the repaired bridge structure will be undertaken on Friday 28 August 2015 with the same operating hours and traffic diversions.

Parking restrictions will also be in force within the car park in front of the Referendum Tower Block as demarcated by no parking signs. Temporary advance road work and diversion signs will be placed on the approach to the works to advise drivers.
