HM Government of Gibraltar regrets to learn of the death of Mr Alan Whiting, former Chairman and member of the Board of the Financial Services Commission. Mr Whiting retired from the Board on serving the maximum period permitted of 9 years, in early 2014, and was a highly respected and popular member. Mr Whiting held senior positions in a number of financial services firms in the United Kingdom as well as in the Treasury Department.
