<u>Jet Ski Incident at Ocean Village</u>

The Gibraltar Port Authority (GPA) attended an incident that occurred yesterday afternoon at around 1530hrs in which a local registered jet ski collided with a berthed yacht inside Ocean Village.

No injuries were sustained by the driver of the Jet Ski or any other person in the area. The reasons for the collision are not yet known. It is believed the driver of the Jet Ski lost control and the Jet Ski slammed into the berthed vessel resulting in the Jet Ski flying over the pier.

The GPA would like to remind all users of any personal water crafts (PWCs) of the power of these vessels and of the need to exercise caution when using such crafts in an enclosed area; especially, when operating near beaches and bathers. The GPA would also take this opportunity to remind all leisure users of the new 5 knots speed limit within the harbour.
