## Another inaugural visit by a cruise ship

Star Breeze, the American owned Windstar Cruises luxury ship, became the eleventh inaugural call of the season when it sailed into Gibraltar yesterday.

With a gross tonnage of 9,975 and a length of 134 metres, Star Breeze has a small passenger capacity of 212.

As is customary on these occasions, Minister for Tourism, the Hon Samantha Sacramento MP was invited on board the vessel for a formal welcome ceremony with the captain and crew.

Ship agents MH Bland and Co were also present and there was the customary exchange of commemorative plaques with the ship's captain.

Representatives from the Gibraltar Port Authority, Deputy Captain of the Port Manuel Tirado and the Gibraltar Tourist Board were also in attendance.

Minister Sacramento expressed her delight at the arrival of yet another vessel making its inaugural call to Gibraltar's bustling port.
