Feetham wants Taxpayers Cash only for Himself

The Government notes that Hassans partner Daniel Feetham thinks it is wrong that the Chief Minister should be indemnified from public funds for the costs involved in having to defend himself against the scandalous allegation made by Mr Feetham's supporter Mr Gingell.

Mr Feetham nonetheless asked in Parliament how he might access taxpayers' money to sue the Chief Minister for defamation because he didn't like the Chief Minister's Budget Reply.
