This major art exhibition is being organised by the Gibraltar Cultural Services, on behalf of the Ministry of Culture. It showcases the works of Royal Academicians: Anne Desmet, Barbara Rae and Ann Christopher to promote, encourage and foster the arts and cultural activities in Gibraltar and to export our culture abroad.

Each class from Year Three right down to Reception was able to visit the exhibition.
