Gibraltar presence in UK party conferences

The Government will this weekend commence Gibraltar's participation at the conferences of the main political parties in the United Kingdom. This year Gibraltar's presence assumes a greater significance following the referendum of 23 June where the United Kingdom voted to leave the European Union.

The Chief Minister Fabian Picardo will head the delegation at the Conservative and Labour Party conferences.

The Deputy Chief Minister Dr Joseph Garcia will do the same at the party conferences of the Liberal Democrats and of the Scottish National Party.

The political conference season starts this weekend with the Liberal Democrat conference in Brighton where Dr Garcia will host the traditional Gibraltar Government reception on Sunday evening.
