The Gibraltar Museum's 'Walks Through History'

The Gibraltar Museum will once again offer their very popular 'Walks through History' over the summer holiday period. The walks are organised by the Museum's Education Department as part of the Gibraltar Sports and Leisure Authority's (GSLA) Summer Sports and Leisure Programme.

The Walks are aimed at children between the ages of 9 and 12 years and will take place on Wednesday mornings. The first of these will be on 20^{th} July, and there will be other Walks on the 27^{th} July, and 3rd, 10^{th} , 17^{th} , 24^{th} and 31^{st} August.

This year's innovation will be the workshops that will give the youngsters an opportunity to take part in experimental archaeological activities including Prehistoric Art and Painting, try their hand at archaeological excavations, and have the opportunity to find out more about the way that pottery was made in ancient times. Other walks will showcase Gibraltar's rich history and cultural heritage, with the opportunity to explore with expert guides, the Moorish Castle and other historic sites, some of which are not normally open to the public, and a boat trip to see the Neanderthal site of Gorham's and Vanguard Caves from the sea where they may be lucky to see dolphins and whales as an added bonus!

We are limited to a maximum of 15 on each walk, children must bring along hats, comfortable clothing, sensible footwear and a drink (they may also wish to bring a camera). We also recommend that they wear sunscreen.

Bookings are on a first come, first served basis.
