Understanding Autism Seminars

Last week, the Ministry of Equality organised a seminar on understanding autism, which was held at the O'Callaghan Eliott Hotel. The event was extremely well attended by parents of children and adults who are on the autistic spectrum. This seminar was presented by Linda Woodcock, coauthor of the book 'Managing Family Meltdown', who is also the parent of a son with autism.

This was the first of a series of lectures in relation to autism that was started on Friday to mark Autism Awareness month. Further seminars will be offered throughout this year.

Speaking at the opening of the seminar, Minister for Equality, the Hon.
