Dr Garcia to Speak at Brexit Convention

The Deputy Chief Minister, Dr Joseph Garcia has been invited to speak as a panellist at a Convention on Brexit which opens in London tomorrow Friday.

This two day event at Central Hall in Westminster will feature politicians and leading cultural figures and will analyse the implications of Brexit and the current political climate. It has been described as the first large scale gathering exclusively devoted to the investigation of Brexit and the defence of progressive and democratic values in the West and about two thousand delegates are expected.

Dr Garcia will speak on Friday morning during a panel discussion entitled 'Will Europe make it? Can the EU meet the challenges of Brexit and populism to reinvent itself?' Other participants in this discussion are Frederic Martel, Charles Grant, Richard Corbett MEP and Louise Rowntree.

Amongst the many speakers expected at The Convention are AC Grayling, Alastair Campbell, Bob Geldof, Lord Heseltine, Michael Gove, Gina Miller, Nick Clegg, and Rachel Johnson.

Dr Garcia will return to Gibraltar at the weekend.
