DEHCC 'electrifies' its motorcycle fleet

In keeping with HM Government of Gibraltar's policy to reduce the emissions produced by its vehicle fleet and thereby improve air quality, the Department of the Environment, Heritage and Climate Change (DEHCC) has today begun replacing its fossil-fuelled motorcycles with electric motorcycles. The electrification of the Department's vehicle fleet is one of the recent measures adopted by the DEHCC to improve its environmental performance by reducing its transport carbon footprint. It is hoped that the initiative will also encourage other entities who are reliant on motorised transport to follow suit and in doing so, help raise awareness on more sustainable modes of transport in Gibraltar.
