WWF's Earth Hour Saturday 30th March 2019 – 8:30pm

Earth Hour has become a worldwide event, organized by WWF, it represents a definitive statement by Civil Society on climate action. Our connection to the planet and nature is a life limit which must be preserved.

As the earth continues to break climate records, the need for greater ambition and commitment is also increasing.

As dusk sets, Gibraltarians are invited to take a stand for climate action and join millions around the world to turn off the lights and speak up about why nature matters.
