### **Short-Term Vacancies Gibraltar Sports & Leisure Authority Summer Sports and Leisure Programmes**

The Gibraltar Sports and Leisure Authority( GSLA) invites applications for Supply and Seasonal part time posts from persons who by virtue of their citizenship are entitled to take up employment and who are, or on employment will be, resident in Gibraltar. The posts are:

- a. **Sports Leader in Charge** – tenable from 21<sup>st</sup> June to 28<sup>th</sup> August 2019. *(NB: Sports Leader in Charge will not be required to work from Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> to Friday 12<sup>th</sup> July 2019 due to this year's Island Games)*
- b. **Sports Leader** – tenable from 24<sup>th</sup> June to 27<sup>th</sup> August 2019. *(NB: Sports Leader positions will not be required to work from Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> to Friday 12<sup>th</sup> July 2019 due to this year's Island Games)*
- c. **Stay and Play Leader in Charge** – tenable from 27<sup>th</sup> June to 28<sup>th</sup> August 2019.
- d. **Stay and Play Leader** – tenable from 28<sup>th</sup> June to 27<sup>th</sup> August 2019.

1. Applicants for all Sports Leadership posts must possess Accredited Sports Specific Coaching Award (minimum Level 1) and/or Community Sports Leadership Level 2 Award.

Applicants must also possess written proof of practical experience of coaching in a sporting environment.

2. Applicants for the Stay and Play programme will need a written reference proving experience of social work and experience of leading and supporting young people with disabilities in a sport, recreational, educational or leisure environment.

3. It is desirable that candidates for all posts have a first aid qualification.
