## Leaving Gibraltar Permanently or Indefinitely (Claim for Final Assessments)

If you are leaving Gibraltar permanently you are entitled to claim for your assessments to be processed to date. To do so you are required to submit the following documentation to the Income Tax Office.

- Claim for Final Assessment form
- Part 1 of your P7A form
- Proof of travels (flight details, utility bill from new address, copies of tolls receipts).
- Bank transfer form (Please include proof of your account details e.g. a bank statement)
- Identity Card or Passport
- Bank form: https://www.gibraltar.gov.gi/income-tax-office/report-changes

If your residence is within a 200km commuting distance from Gibraltar, your claim will not be accepted.

When submitting your claim, please ensure that all outstanding tax returns and any other necessary documents for the claim process are provided. Failing to do so may cause delays in the processing of your assessments.

Assessments will be apportioned on the number of months or weeks worked in any given tax year, as per the Rates of Tax Rules 1989.
