## Learning from Auschwitz Talk Available Online and with Subtitles

The Ministry of Equality has released a recording of the presentation titled 'Learning From Auschwitz', that was delivered by Mr. Arek Hersh, a Holocaust Survivor and Mr Mike Levy, a Holocaust Education Advisor, on the 7th December 2017. The recording of the talk was organized in order to ensure that Mr Hersh's testimonial could be heard by the widest possible audience.

The video will be released on 8th May to commemorate the liberation of the Theresienstadt Camp. Arek Hersh had been held at a number of concentration camps during the Second World War, including Auschwitz and Buchenwald, but it was at Theresienstadt where Arek was finally liberated on 8th May 1945.
