An Accessible Toilet is a toilet designed to accommodate people with physical disabilities. Public toilets can present accessibility challenges for people with disabilities, for example: stalls may not be able to fit a wheelchair, and transferring between wheelchair and toilet seat may not be easy. Accessible toilets are designed to address these issues by providing more space and handrails to grab and hold during transfers.

An Accessible Undersized Toilet provides all the facilities available in an Accessible toilet, but has a reduced internal area (less than 3x4m²).

A **Changing Place Toilet** is larger than an Accessible toilet and has extra equipment as detailed below:

- Height adjustable adult-sized changing bench
- Ceiling tracking hoist system
- Space in the changing area for the person with a disability and up to two personal assistants
- Centrally placed toilet with room either side
- Privacy screen
- Tear off bench paper roll
- Large waste bin
- Non-slip floor
- Wash basin (height adjustable)

The **RADAR Key** may be applied for by individuals with certain disabilities and/or impairments.



The scheme consists on the availability of a skeleton key, which will enable keyholders to have access to an Accessible Public Toilet after its opening hours.
