All organic waste which is any material that is biodegradable and comes from either plant or animal sources. Biodegradable waste can breakdown easily in nature.

Some examples include: leftover fruit and vegetables, scraps of meat and fish, the shells of eggs, seafood and nuts, coffee grounds, tea bags, and small garden waste such as leaves and flowers.
