

General Notes

If you find that you cannot keep an appointment given to you, you should notify the Department of Transport, giving at least three clear days notice, otherwise you may be required to pay a further fee if you want another appointment.

You are required on the date of your appointment to show a valid learners licence to drive the category of vehicle in respect of which you are applying.

There shall be clearly displayed in a conspicuous manner on the front and back of the vehicle driven by a learner a distinguishing mark, consisting of the letter “L” in red colour on a white background, which shall conform with Reg 85 (3) of the Tra (Lic & Reg) Regulations.

Eligibility

In addition to the qualifying period of 185 days, applicants must also possess legal residence in Gibraltar, i.e. Permit of Residence or I.D. Card.

You are ineligible to take a driving test within two weeks of a previous test in a vehicle of the same category
