Passport applications can be rejected or delayed if incorrectly submitted. Please note that the appropriate fee is charged when the application is received and is non-refundable and non-transferable, even if you decide to withdraw your application at some stage or your application is unsuccessful.

- I also understand that a child who has already attained 16 years of age upon application, will be issued with a ten year passport and the adult fee will apply.



Take or send this form to the Nationality and Passport section of the Civil Status and Registration Office, Joshua Hassan House, Secretary's Lane, Gibraltar, with your current passport the prescribed fee, two photographs and any documents required. Whilst you may be allowed to retain your current passport, it is advisable that you do not make use of your passport whilst the application is being processed, given that your passport is automatically cancelled when we initiate the processing of your application, and you may have difficulties if you do so. Please note that if you retain your passport it must be presented for cancellation on collection of the new passport.

We may check information about you with other information we have. We may get information about you from other people and certain other organisations. We may give information to certain other organisations, as the law allows, to:

- check the accuracy of information;
- prevent or detect crime;
- · protect public funds in other ways; and
- use in research or statistics.

These other organisations include other government departments, local authorities, and private sector bodies such as banks and organisations that may lend you money. We will not give information about you to anyone outside our department unless the law allows us to.
