- 6. If the application is for a child, I have parental responsibility and I have enclosed any court orders that relate to the child's residence, contact or removal from Gibraltar/country of residence;
- 7. I, or the person named in section 2 (if different) understand that by voluntarily applying for a British passport, I may lose my citizenship of another country;
- 8. I also understand that a child who has already attained 16 years of age upon application, will be issued with a ten year passport and the adult fee will apply.

I am also aware that the Civil Status and Registration Office holds and uses data in accordance with the Data Protection Act 2004. Information about this application may be shared with appropriate public and private sector authorities.



Please note that if you retain your passport it must be presented for cancellation on collection of the new passport.
