PREFACE

These are the fifty-second and fifty-third Employment Surveys conducted in Gibraltar and the forty-fourth and forty-fifth under the Statistics Ordinance (Employment Survey Order 1971 as Amended) 1970.

The purpose of such surveys is to obtain up-to-date information regarding trends in employment and earnings of all employees in Gibraltar. This information assists the Gibraltar Government with decisions on labour matters and is also useful for the compilation of National Accounts for Gibraltar.

COVERAGE

1. During 1997 returns were received from all known employers in respect of their employees, the information received being processed through computer. The response rate was good with only a small number of employers excluded from the final report.

SUMMARY OF THE RESULTS

- 1. The employment statistics as at October 1996 show a marginal decrease in the overall level of employment from 12,980 in April 1996 to 12,975 (-0.04%) followed by a small rise from 12,975 to 13,000 in April 1997 (+0.2%).
- 2. The main employment trends during the period covered by this report can be summarised as follows:
- (a) Employment in the Construction Industry (Tables 12A & 12B) increased during the period in question, from 1,082 in April 1996 to 1,169 in October 1996 (+8.0%), and continued to increase from 1,169 to 1,248 in April 1997 (+6.8%).
- (b) During the same period employment in Banking, Finance and Insurance has shown a small increase while Retail Trade continued to decrease from 1,665 in April 1996 to 1,561 in April 1997 (-6.2%).
- (c) The largest percentage increase in numbers employed, by occupational group in the period April 1996 to October 1996, was recorded in respect of Production and Construction workers rising from 3,019 in April 1996 to 3,147 in October 1996 (+4.2%). The Production and Construction workers group rose from 3,147 in October 1996 to 3,216 in April 1997 (+2.2%).
- 3(a) Average weekly earnings for full-time adult men rose from £232.02 in April 1996 to £249.31 in October 1996 (+7.5%), but then decreased from £249.31 to £226.82 in April 1997 (-9.0%).
- (b) Earnings for these male workers in the Private Sector increased by 3.3% over the period, from £219.54 in April 1996 to £226.74 in October 1996 but fell by 2.8% from £226.74 to £220.30 in April 1997.
- (c) Earnings in respect of monthly-paid male employees rose by 3.9% from £1,450.84 in April 1996 to £1,507.98 in October 1996 and increased by 2.3% from £1,507.98 to £1,542.17 in April 1997.
- (d) Average earnings for full-time monthly-paid employees in October 1996 were £1,537.92 for adult males and £1,126.61 for adult females, rising to £1,574.75 for adult males and rising to £1,172.81 for adult females in April 1997.
